About ICEBERG Project

35 public and private organisations from ten European countries take part in the ICEBERG project -acronym for Innovative Circular Economy Based solutions demonstrating the Efficient recovery of valuable material Resources from the Generation of representative End-of-Life building materials- funded by the European Union as part of the Horizon 2020 Research and Innovation Framework Programme (contract 869336). It aims to tackle the recycling and recovery of some of the most common construction and demolition waste (C&DW). The project will last for four years (2020-2024) and has a budget of €15,667,498, of which the European Union is providing €12,997,935.


